

Types of medical care provided at the State Budget health institution

"Vyborg Interdistrict Hospital"

- primary health care, incl. pre-medical;
- primary medical and primary specialized health care;
- specialized, incl. high tech medical help;
- palliative care (department of palliative care in the village Soviet).

Medical assistance is provided in the following forms:

- emergency;
- emergency;
- planned.

Primary health care is at the core of the system.

medical care and includes activities for prevention, diagnosis, treatment of diseases and conditions, medical rehabilitation, monitoring pregnancy, healthy lifestyles and sanitary-hygienic education of the population.

Organization of primary health care citizens in order to approach their place of residence, place work or training is carried out according to territorial the local principle of group formation of the served population at the place of residence, place of work or studies in certain organizations.

Primary health care is provided in outpatient and day care in planned and emergency form.

Primary pre-medical health care is provided paramedics, obstetricians and other medical professionals with secondary medical education.

Primary medical care is provided general practitioners, district general practitioners, general practitioners pediatricians, district pediatricians and general practitioners practice (family doctors).

Primary Specialized Health Care

turns out to be specialist doctors, including specialist doctors specialized medical organizations in including high-tech, medical care.

Specialized care is provided in stationary conditions and in the conditions of a day hospital specialist doctors and includes prevention, diagnosis and treatment of diseases and conditions (including period of pregnancy, childbirth and the postpartum period) requiring use of special methods and complex medical technology, as well as medical rehabilitation.

High-tech medical care as part of specialized medical care includes application of new complex and (or) unique methods of treatment, and also resource-intensive treatment methods with scientifically proven efficiency, including cell technology, robotic technology, information technology and

Achievements in Genetic Engineering medical science and related branches of science and technology.

Ambulance, including specialized ambulance, medical assistance is provided to citizens in emergency or emergency form outside the medical organization, as well as in outpatient and stationary conditions for diseases, accidents, injuries, poisoning and other conditions requiring urgent medical intervention.

Ambulance, including specialized ambulance, medical assistance is provided by medical organizations state and municipal health systems.

When providing emergency medical care in case of medical evacuation is necessary, representing the transportation of citizens for rescue

life and health (including those on treatment in medical institutions in which there is no the ability to provide the necessary medical care with life-threatening conditions, women during pregnancy, childbirth, the postpartum period and newborns, persons affected as a result of emergencies and natural disasters). Medical evacuation is carried out by field teams

ambulance with during transportation of medical care activities, including with the use of medical equipment.

When providing medical care, sanitary air evacuation. Sanitary Procedure evacuation is determined by the legal act of the Committee on healthcare of the Leningrad region.

Palliative care is provided in outpatient and inpatient conditions by medical personnel who have passed training to provide such assistance and constitutes complex medical interventions aimed at getting rid from pain and relief of other severe manifestations of the disease, in order to improve the quality of life of terminally ill citizens.

Medical assistance is provided in the following forms:

- emergency - medical care provided at sudden acute diseases, conditions, exacerbation chronic life-threatening diseases the patient;
- emergency - medical care provided at sudden acute diseases, conditions, exacerbation chronic diseases without obvious signs of a life threat the patient;
- planned - medical assistance provided during preventive measures for diseases and conditions, not accompanied by a threat to the life of the patient, not requiring emergency and emergency medical care

which for a certain time will not entail deterioration the condition of the patient, a threat to his life and health.

Medical assistance may be provided in the following conditions:

- outside the medical organization (at the place of call of the brigade ambulance, including specialized ambulance, medical assistance, as well as in a vehicle with medical evacuation);
- outpatient (in conditions not stipulating round-the-clock medical supervision and treatment), including number at home when calling a health worker;
- in a day hospital (in the conditions providing

medical observation and daytime treatment but not requiring round-the-clock medical supervision and treatment);

- stationary (in conditions providing round-the-clock medical supervision and treatment).

To receive medical care, citizens have the right to choice of a doctor, including a general practitioner (family doctor) and the attending physician (subject to the consent of the doctor), as well as a choice

medical organization in accordance with the law Russian Federation.
